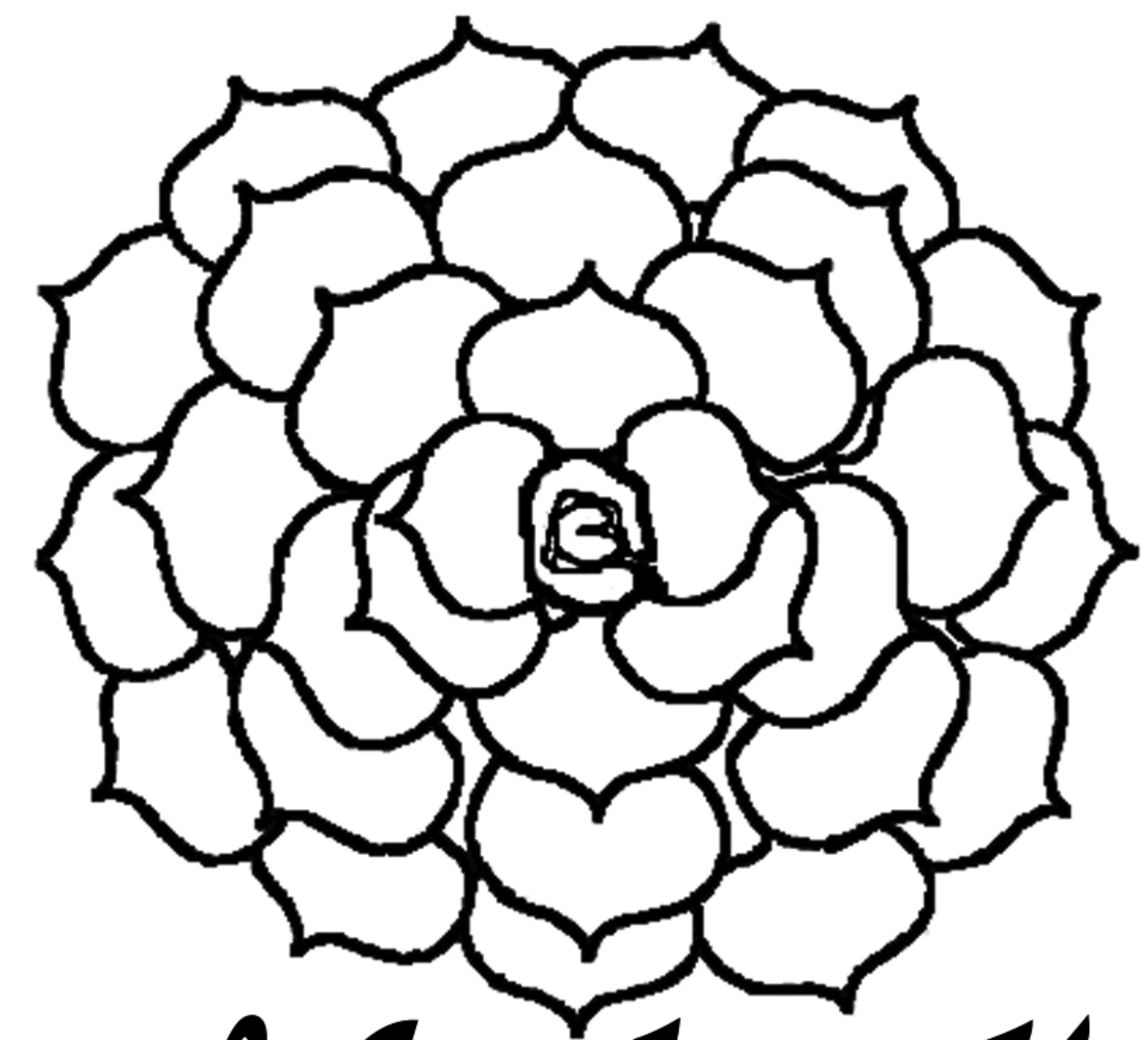

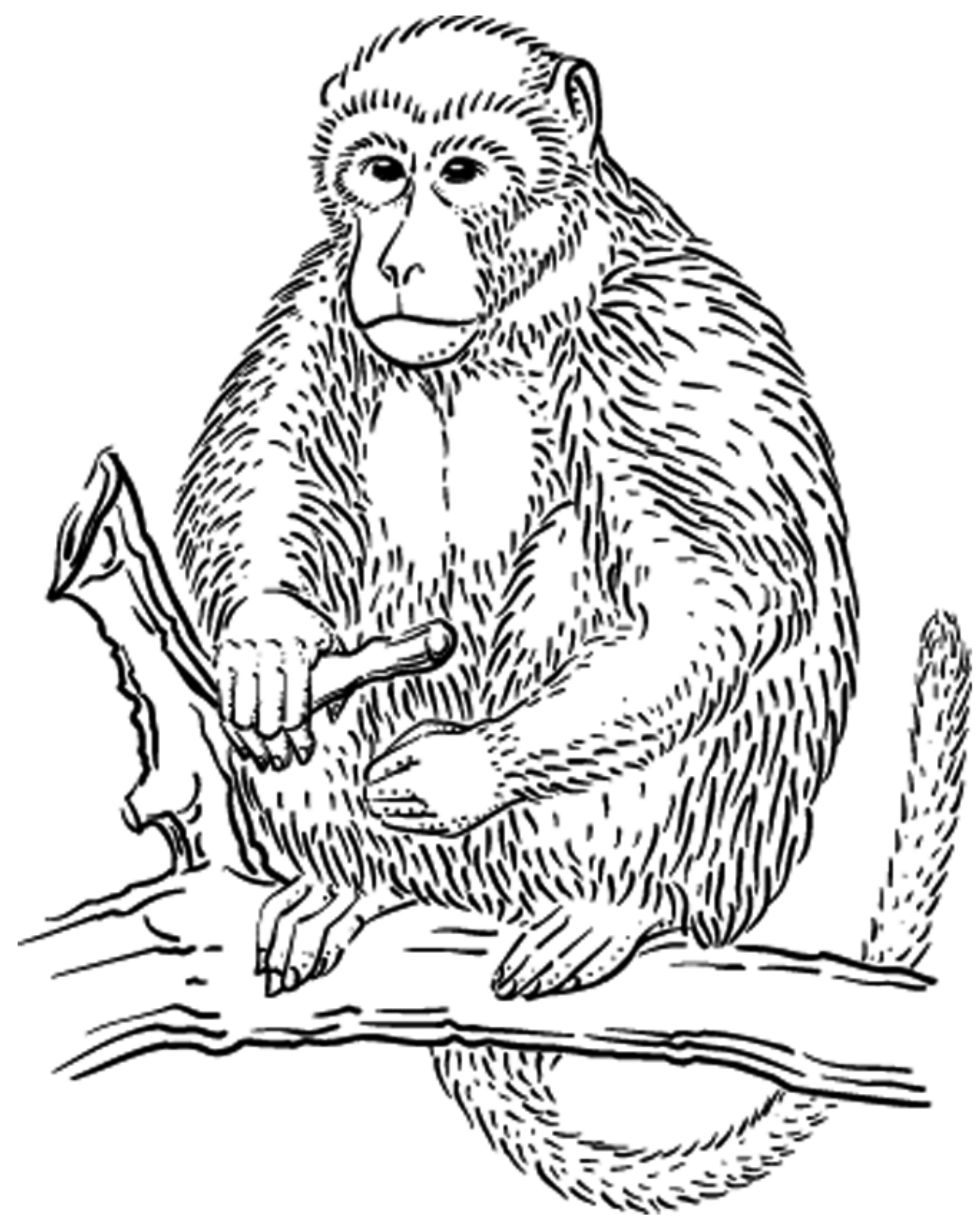


# Mankind's Secret History
